



Automatically Clear Browsing Data When Closing Edge

Open Edge and click the Ellipsis in the upper right corner. Select Settings.



In the Settings menu, click on Cookies and site permissions.



In the Cookies and data stored section, click the arrow for Manage and delete cookies and site data.

Cookies and data stored

Save cookies and data on your device in order to facilitate continuous browsing between sites and sessions

Manage and delete cookies and site data >

In the Cookies and data stored section, click on the link “Clear browsing data on close.”

Cookies and data stored / Cookies and site data

Allow sites to save and read cookie data (recommended)

Block third-party cookies
When on, sites can't use cookies that track you across the web. Features on some sites may break.

Preload pages for faster browsing and searching
Uses cookies to remember your preferences, even if you don't visit those pages



In the Clear browsing data on close page, click the toggle for Browsing history and Cookies and other site data. If there are sites you don't want to clear this information for, add the URLs by clicking the Add button.



Now your browsing data will be cleared every time you close Edge. So if you get an error in RFP & Proposal Express or when trying to Create a Proposal, you will only need to close out your browser and reopen it.
